The client's private space is accessed by an electro-dimmable sliding glass door, giving access to a vast business desk and a large U-shaped sofa. The lounge area can configure two double beds too.

As you keep walking down the jet, you arrive to a full Master Suite bedroom and bathroom. Within the room, there is a rather impressive 64" TV, which is the largest currently offered for a certified aircraft interior. The owner's bathroom is an exceptional place to be. The centrepiece is a custom-made blue glass washbasin, with a large shower and a mirror-faced TV which is masterfully integrated into the marble vanity area.
